Public transport and taxi

Warsaw is well connected thanks to its developed public transportation network. We recommend using the following transport options:

metro

bus/nightbus

tram

taxi/Uber/Bolt

Public Transport

Various types of public transport tickets are available, which can be purchased either online or at ticket machines located at metro stations and bus or tram stops. For buses, tickets can also be purchased and validated directly on the vehicle.

It's important to note that all tickets must be validated before use. For buses and trams, this can be done by using the validation machines on board. In the metro, tickets should be validated at the gates before entering the platform.

A useful application for navigating public transport in the city and purchasing tickets is **Jakdojade**. It provides real-time information on public transport routes and allows you to buy tickets. You can download it here:

Taxi services

Taxis can be easily ordered via the Uber or Bolt applications, which are available for download here:

Getting from the airport to the conference venue

By train

There is a number of available train connections between the Chopin airport and the centre of Warsaw (approx. 25 min.). You can take any train that stops at Warszawa Centralna station (approx. 300m from the Hotel Mercure Warszawa Centrum, where the venue takes place) or Warszawa Śródmieście station (approx. 600m from the hotel, no facilities for the disabled). The cost of a single ticket is 4,40 PLN (approx. 1 EUR).

By bus

Alternatively, you can take a bus no. 175 directly from the Chopin airport to Warszawa Centralna station (approx. 300m from the Hotel Mercure Warszawa Centrum, where the venue takes place). The journey takes approx. 45 min (depending on the traffic). The cost of a single ticket is 4,40 PLN.

If you take public transport (train or bus) we recommend that you buy single ticket and validate it on board. Depending on vending machine, the ticket looks as one of indicated below:





By taxi

For safety reasons we strongly advise you to use licensed taxi services offered at Warsaw Chopin Airport. Taxi tariffs should be clearly displayed in the car window. You can also request a ride with Uber/Bolt/Taxify. They operate from official pick up points in front of the arrival gate. The cost of the ride to the city centre should not exceed 15 EUR.

Means of payment and currency

Cash

The currency in Poland is the Polish Złoty (PLN) 1 PLN = 100 groszy. Coins: 1 PLN, 2 PLN, 5 PLN and 10, 20 and 50 groszy. Banknotes: 10, 20, 50, 100, 200 and 500 PLN

Currency Exchange

Usually, 1 PLN \approx 0.23 EUR, 1 PLN \approx 0.25 USD

Currency should be exchanged at registered exchange points, which are available throughout the city. Alternatively, Polish złoty (PLN) can be withdrawn from ATMs, which are widely available across Warsaw. Please note that when withdrawing money from a foreign account, your bank may charge a fee, so it is advisable to check with your bank before making withdrawals.

Payment method

Besides cash, **credit cards** (e.g., Visa, MasterCard) and **debit cards** (e.g., Maestro) are widely accepted. However, your bank may charge a fee for currency exchange when card payments are made. It's advisable to check with your bank regarding any potential fees before your trip.
